

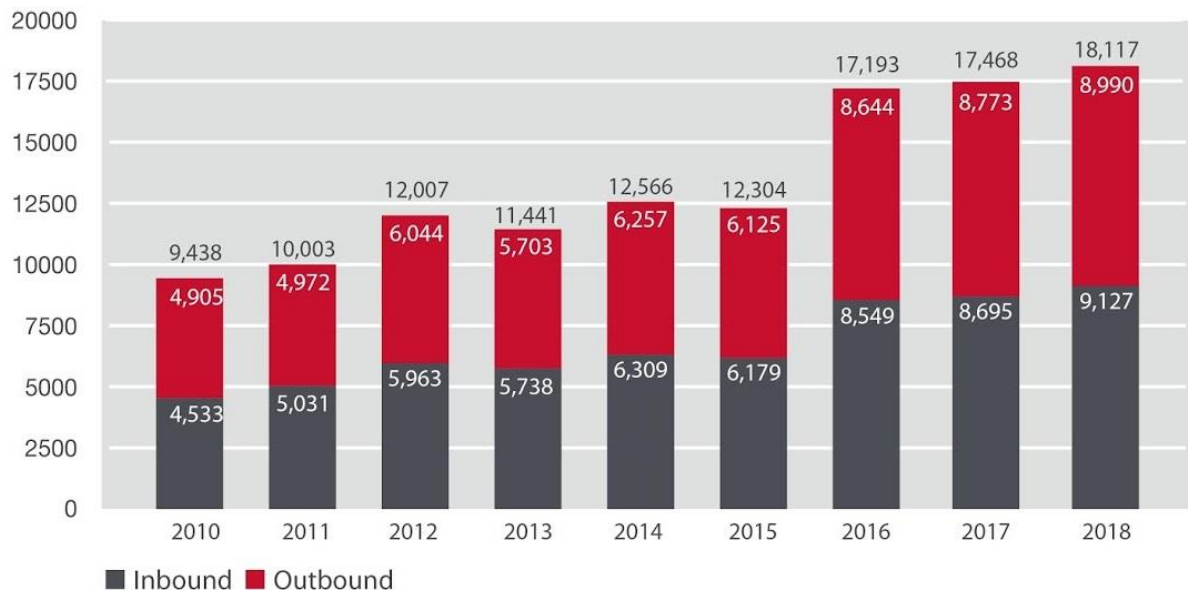


2018 Bicycle and pedestrian count for cycling statistics:

- 18,117 total bicycle trips entering and exiting downtown Calgary on a typical weekday in May 2018.
 - 8,990 were outbound
 - 9,127 were inbound
- Including winter operations, the downtown cycle track averages 600 bicycle trips per weekday, 3,500 trips per week and 15,000 trips per month.
- As noted in the [graph](#), we've noticed an 81 per cent increase in total downtown bicycle trips since May 2011.

2016 Bicycle and pedestrian count for cycling statistics:

- About 30 per cent of summer cyclists stay on the road over the winter.
- Four times as many daily winter bike trips in Calgary thanks to the downtown cycle track and improvements to the city's pathway system.

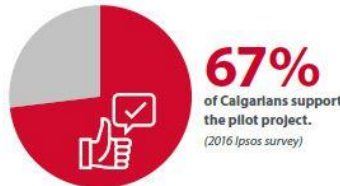
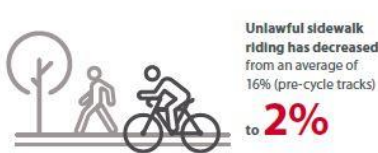
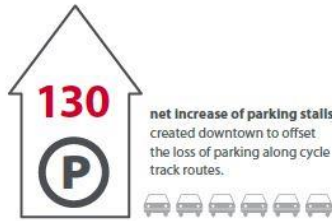
