Provincial funding support is needed for highest priorities

- Flood mitigation on the Bow and Elbow Rivers

Commit to upstream flood mitigation and water storage on Bow River



Calgary's **downtown and Bow River** communities are still at risk for flooding and **need protection**

- A future Bow River reservoir to manage flood, drought, and water supply in the face of climate uncertainty
- Provincial support needed to complete technical work and immediately fund the best upstream solutions to protect Calgary
- Continued Provincial support of Calgary's community-level flood mitigation



Extend the 2016 five-year agreement between the Province and TransAlta to help protect communities along the Bow River against the impacts of both floods and drought
